

Driving Directions to Prague Lake

- A. From either I-44 (Turner Turnpike) or Hwy 66 (coming from Tulsa or OKC) arrive in the town of Stroud. Take exit 179 on the Turner Turnpike. Go south on Hwy 377 (aka SH 99) to Prague.
 - a. Note – there is construction on I-44 (Turner Turnpike) between Sapulpa and Bristow.
- B. Take Hwy 377 (aka SH 99), approximately 19 miles, into the town of Prague.
 - a. Note - Google maps will take you a shorter way, however, the roads are rougher.
- C. In Prague turn west at the stoplight onto Hwy 62 towards Meeker.
- D. Go 3 miles west to 3520 Road and turn north. (The roads are paved, but rough. If you turn on a dirt road you have made a mistake).
- E. Go 2 miles north to 1030 Road. There will be a small white sign on the right indicating the turn. Watch for horses on the road.

From Highway 40, take the Prague exit (MM 200) and go north approximately 9 miles, then follow directions above at C.
